Growth in moral strength and character

We may define this as what the boy is himself: his qualities, his values, his outlook.



Development in physical, mental and emotional fitness

Fitness includes the body (well tuned and healthy), the mind (able to think and solve problems), and the emotions (self-control, courage, and self-respect)

Participating in Citizenship

Used broadly, citizenship means boy's relationship to others. He comes to learn obligations to other people, to the society he lives in, and to the government that presides over that society.

THE COST OF SCOUTING
